**CAMPUS-WIDE SIMULTANEOUS
EVACUATION DRILL**

Checklist of Actions to take when Earthquake strikes

(Follow steps ① to ④ below)

※ Pay attention to the emergency earthquake warning relayed through the speakers.

- ① Take personal protective action for two minutes to reduce chance of injury (see the figures below).
- ② Evacuate from the building to a nearby outdoor safe space (temporary evacuation area) using the designated evacuation route.
- ③ Upon arrival at the temporary evacuation area, report your presence to the person in charge.
- ④ Respond to the Safety Confirmation Email sent to you to confirm your current safety status.

If you are inside a building, move no more than a few step, then **Drop, Cover, and Hold** :



- 1 DROP to the ground (before the earthquake drops you!).
- 2 Take COVER by getting under a sturdy desk or table.
- 3 HOLD ON to it until the shaking stops.
